Note: The Registration Form includes an area to collect flight information. Otherwise, it is assumed that individuals will find their own transportation to/from Bergamo Center.

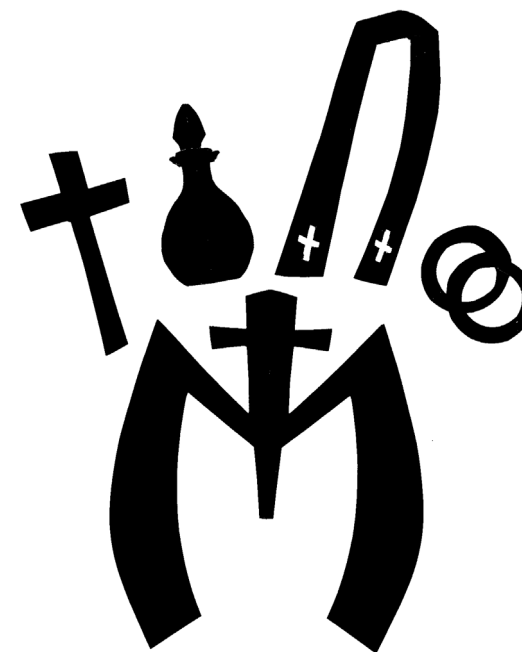
